A few of the major focus areas for the 2019-2020 school year include:

- Curriculum Reviews and Revisions:
 - As a follow-up to the K-12 English Language Arts curriculum review, the 2019-2020 school year will mark the launch of a multi-year literacy action plan. Science and School Counseling will also be creating action plans based on their formal curriculum reviews to be completed in the spring of 2019 and will begin addressing the identified areas of need. Additionally, Technology Education and Informational Digital Literacy (Library Media) will complete their initial curriculum review and revision and begin implementation of their revised units of study. As part of the initial Information Digital Literacy curriculum work, K-12 research skills and digital citizenship continuums will be designed and "rolled out" during the 2019-2020 school year to all grades and departments. Furthermore, the reimaging of the Library Media Centers as flexible learning spaces offering both access to information and the ability to create (e.g., Makerspaces) will continue. Makerspaces are collaborative learning spaces that provide students with tools and materials which encourage inquiry in science, engineering, and technology through experimentation, design, invention, and creation using an interactive, hands-on environment.
- Teacher on Special Assignment/Enrichment Coach:
 The work begun in the area of enrichment during 2018-2019 will continue as a focus in 2019-2020. The enrichment coach is tasked with providing support and growth opportunities for K-6 teachers in the areas of differentiation, compacting, and enrichment. Further, the enrichment coach will assist the three elementary schools with Enrichment Clusters and will continue to strengthen our relationship with the Renzulli Center for Creativity, Gifted Education, and Talent Development at UConn.
- Professional Development:
 - The professional development budget continues to support curriculum and instruction, school culture and climate (e.g., culturally responsive teaching, restorative practices) in addition to ensuring our curriculum is accessible for all students by providing additional teacher training and support focused on accommodations, differentiation, and assessments.
