**STUDENT PARKING RULES**

- 1) Parking is a privilege open to **juniors** who demonstrate a need. The student must have a valid driver's license, maintain good school citizenship, to include academics, attendance, and discipline record.
- 2) Early consideration is given to juniors with qualified dual enrollment (ex. college course, partial day at a magnet school).
- 3) Junior parking is a rolling application process, provided there are parking spaces available.
- 4) Privileges may be revoked or suspended and other penalties, including fines, applied for violating any of the following:
  - a. **Failure to maintain satisfactory school citizenship and minimum course requirements.**
  - b. **Leaving school grounds without permission.**
  - c. **Entering or leaving the school through an unauthorized entry/exit point.**
  - d. **Taking underclassmen or seniors without senior privileges off campus.**
  - e. Parking in areas other than those designated for the student.
  - f. Parking in visitors' spaces before 2:15 p.m.
  - g. Driving the wrong way **in any "one-way"** designated area, i.e. by field hockey field (during dismissal time 2-2:45 p.m.).
  - h. Speeds over 10 miles per hour in the parking lot or any other act that may endanger lives or personal property.
  - i. Failure to display permit decal (must be placed on the windshield, lower corner, passenger side).
  - j. Providing false or non-current information on the parking application.

- k. Violating any Connecticut Motor Vehicle or criminal laws.
- 2. Every student driver must comply with Connecticut's Graduated Driver Licensing laws including the nighttime curfew restrictions, passenger restrictions, and all drivers and passengers must wear a seat belt. If any of these regulations is violated, the student may have their drivers' licenses seized by a police officer immediately. The student driver will be subject to any other consequences by law.
- 3. Permits can only be issued for the student's vehicle(s) and are non-transferable to another vehicle.
- 4. **Cars illegally parked on-campus are subject to fines and may be towed at the owner's expense.**
- 5. There will be **no** exceptions to this process. *Failure to comply with any of these guidelines will result in loss of parking privileges.*

**PARKING FEES**

The parking fee per year is \$150.00 or on a monthly prorated basis. See the attached month by month rate. **A check payable to *Avon High School*, a *photocopy of registration*, and a *photocopy of the student's driver's license* must accompany this application in order for it to be processed. No cash will be accepted.**
