Dear Class of 2021:

Starting Monday, August 3, 2020 **senior student parking applications** will be available online for the 2020-2021 school year. These permits are only meant for **senior students** who will be driving a vehicle registered to them or their families and not for a friend's car.

Parking applications must be filled out completely and returned with proof of a current operator's license and vehicle registration. **ONLY A VALID CONNECTICUT DRIVER'S LICENCE WILL BE ACCEPTED. PERMITS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** Please hand in a check for \$150.00 payable to Avon High School. **Cash will NOT be accepted.** Proof of registration means the student must submit a copy of the registration of the car(s) they will be driving to school. Students must show they have an operator's license before a parking permit will be issued to them. *All applications must be turned into the office no later than Friday, August 7, 2020 in order to guarantee a parking space for the school year.* Parking Permit decals may be **picked up on Wednesday, August 26 from 10:00am - 12:00pm and Thursday, August 27, 2020 from 12:00pm - 2:30 pm** in the Old Gym. ***Students must fulfill all outstanding obligations (return textbooks, pay any outstanding fees) in order to receive their parking permit.***

Applications will only be accepted once they are filled out completely, as described above and must include the \$150.00 parking fee. If the application is not fully completed, it will be returned.

Please be sure to read all the rules under parking privileges and know what you are signing. To be accepted, this application **MUST** be signed by **BOTH** the student and the parent/guardian. Remember this parking permit is a **PRIVILEGE**, and may be suspended at any time for violating any of these rules.

There are a limited number of parking spaces available, so return your applications as soon as possible.

**Please remember to follow all social distancing rules including wearing a mask when you drop off the applications and on the day of the permit pick up. Thank you.**
