Delta Sigma Theta Scholarship - Each year the Hartford Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated selects up to four African-American young women to receive a scholarship based on the applicant's academic achievement and community involvement. In addition to receiving the initial award, scholarship recipients enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited four-year college who maintain a 3.0 GPA can apply for a renewal award. Glenn Moon Scholarship - This scholarship is open to graduates of the class of 2020 who are committed to pursuing a career in the field of education. There is one scholarship of \$2,000 for four years and two one-year scholarships of \$1,500. Applications are available online at www.artct.org

Robert T. Kenney Scholarship - This foundation will award scholarships to over 375 students attending community colleges, 4-year colleges or universities, and vocational programs across the US. Students must have a 2.5 GPA or be in the top 1/3 of their class. Additional eligibility requirements are posted online at www.asfdn.org

Middlesex County Blue Star Mothers - This scholarship awards \$750 to a CT high school senior attending a four-year college in the fall who has a parent or legal guardian actively serving in the military or who is an honorably discharged veteran. College Club of Hartford - The club will award \$1500 in scholarships to qualified female students in Hartford County who have applied to accredited four-year colleges or universities for next year. The scholarship is awarded based off of achievement, character, leadership, and financial need. More information and applications are available in Naviance.

The Catholic Graduates Club of Greater Hartford - Three scholarships of \$2,000 each are available for use during the 2020-2021 academic year. Applicants must be a Catholic student residing in Hartford County, presently attending an accredited secondary school, and planning to attend a four-year college (not necessary to be a Catholic college). The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of financial need, scholarship, character, achievement, and leadership qualities. Applications are available in Naviance.

The American Association of Family and Consumer Sciences, CT Affiliate - A \$1,000 scholarship is available to a graduating high school senior who will be majoring in family and

St. Mary's Women's Guild - This scholarship will award three scholarships of at least \$1,000 each to any member of St. Mary's Parish, Unionville, presently attending a public, parochial or private secondary school who wishes to pursue his/her education and is in need of financial assistance. CT State USBC Association Scholars of the Year - Two academic scholarships of \$1,000 will be awarded to a student who has a parent or grandparent who is a current member of the CT State USBC Association or who holds a current youth membership. SBM Charitable Foundation Scholarships - The Foundation annually awards scholarships in amounts up to \$5000 per year to help fund undergraduate study at institutions of higher learning in Connecticut. Ethnic Minority Scholarship - This scholarship is open to graduating high school ethnic minority students from CT who have shown previous interest in becoming an educator, has been accepted into an accredited four-year CT college or university, and who clearly intends to enter the teaching profession. \$2,000 renewable each year with a 3.0 GPA. Westinghouse W-WIN Scholarship - This scholarship is open to female students graduating from high school in Hartford County and planning to pursue a STEM major. There are three scholarships available (\$1,000, \$740, and \$500). **Application deadline has been extended to April 30** and applications are available in Naviance.

CHESLA Scholarship - Must be a Connecticut resident attending a Connecticut institution with an EFC of 6000 or less (as shown on the SAR/FAFSA) and a GPA of at least 2.5.
