

A number of parents/guardians have asked for some suggestions relative to supplemental school work for their children to engage in over the vacation week. Listed below are a few options:

- Continue to engage in daily reading (remember you can use Raz Kids)
 - PK-Grade 1 20 minutes of shared or independent reading
 - Grades 2-4 30 minutes of independent reading

- Continue to practice math facts
 - Grades K-2 10 minutes of practice with basic math facts
 - Grades 3-4 15 minutes of practice with addition, subtraction, multiplication, & division facts

- **Genius Hour at Home** - Children can develop a passion for learning and develop inquisitive and critical thinking habits by applying the principles of Genius Hour at home. Using an instructional presentation, children are led through an inquiry process to learn deeply about a topic of their choice. The project involves research that expands their knowledge, is shared with others at the end, and is something the child is passionate about.

- **Innovate & Invent** - Children, faced with new ways to learn and create social distance, are apt to find creative ways to manage or even thrive in these new conditions. They can grow these ideas using the invention cycle presented in an instructional presentation that promotes innovation, problem solving and innovation.
