TBS CARES! Care, Acceptance, Respect, Empathy, Safety

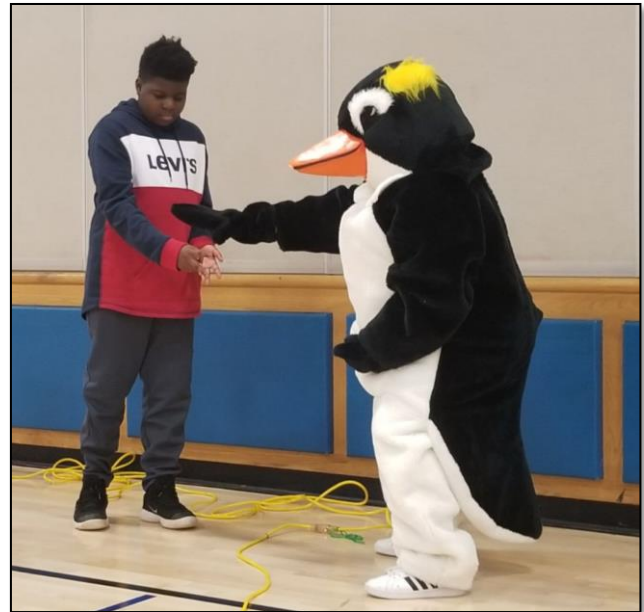
Welcome Back Students!
